Parade Unit General Rules and

Guidelines Entry Selection

Entries should be memorable and can be inspirational, educational, and entertaining. The Avon Heritage Duck Tape® Parade will not be used as a platform for special interests.

Types of Entries Accepted for the Avon Heritage Duck® Tape Parade

Floats: Families, businesses or individuals.

Marching: School Bands, Drum Corp, Independent Bands, and any type of group or organization

Festival Royalty: Royalty courts from other festivals

Vehicles: Antique, specialty vehicles, vehicle pulling float, vehicle carrying Festival royalty and motorcycles.

Walking/: Bicycles, Tricycles and Wagons are encouraged to decorate their non-motorized vehicles.

Other: Drill and Dance Teams, Baton Corps, Majorette, Scouts, political, etc.

Animals: Must provide own refuse clean up.

Official Parade Rules and Regulations

- The application form must be completed and signed with the understanding of the official parade rules and regulations in order to participate.
- **NO THROWING OF ITEMS FROM FLOATS, CARS, TRUCKS OR OTHER UNITS** – You must walk up and directly hand favors, candy, handouts, etc. This is under the order of the Avon Police Department; violators will not be allowed to participate in the 2021 parade.
- All entries are required to maintain a continuous forward motion during the parade with no big gaps and exercise all precautions for the safety of others.
- Entries must use a safety chain with any trailer hitch.
- No flash-mobs permitted during the parade.
- Entrants shall be responsible for their participants, animals, floats, vehicle, etc. Keeping your entry in order and under control at all times is your responsibility and executes our Hold-Harmless Indemnity clause.
- The driver of each entry must be available at all times to move the unit in the event of an emergency or relocation.
- **No alcoholic beverages** – Intoxicated participants will be prohibited from participating in the parade.
- **Food sales are prohibited at the parade lineup.** There will be coffee, water and breakfast items available for purchase by a local organization.
- The Avon Fire Department has the right to inspect floats prior to the parade (max. size limit is 12 feet high and 8.5 feet wide).
- A fire extinguisher(s) with a NON-EXPIRED DATE must be in ALL MOVING VEHICLES complying with State and Local Fire Codes.
- The Avon Heritage Duck Tape® Festival reserves the right to remove a person or persons from any parade unit that determines to be overcrowded to such an extent that the unit may breakdown or cause injury to participants and/or spectators.
- Take parade route length (approximately 1.2 miles) into consideration for younger participants who may get tired and potentially slow down the parade.
- There is NO general parking for parade spectators at the staging area (Avon High School).
- If you are not leaving your float, proceed to the back of the festival grounds by the baseball fields. Please be aware that there will be a long delay and you will not be able to leave until the parade is officially over.
- All entries must complete the entire parade route and disband at this location except for official city emergency and oversized vehicles.

Float Award Categories

- The Avon Heritage Duck Tape® Parade and Float competition is open to all organizations, individuals and groups who have pre-registered.
- All parade floats must be original creations, not previously entered into any Avon Heritage Duck Tape® Festival parade. Previous float entries will be disqualified from winning any prize.
- Floats shall **ONLY** be constructed using Duck® Brand Duct Tape.
- Floats **DO NOT** have to adhere to the festival theme.
- Paid float entries will be provided with 60 rolls of Duck® Brand Duct Tape. Additional rolls of Duck Tape® can be purchased at local retail outlets.
- A select panel of judges, hand selected by the Parade Coordinator, will judge floats.
- Judging will start at 8:00 a.m. prior to the start of the parade.
- Winners will be announced at the main festival stage at approximately 2:00 p.m. You do not need to be present to win.
- The judges will consider Originality (25%), Use of Colors (25%), Workmanship (25%), and Use of Duct Tape (25%).

Prize Categories are:

- 1st Place – \$750
- 2nd Place – \$500
- Rookie – First time participating in the parade - \$500
- Best Use of Music on float - \$100
- Legend Award – Awarded to organization, individual or group who have participated in 5 or more parades – Trophy
- Spirit Award – Given to the entry that has the most enthusiasm during the parade – Trophy
